### Under 16/14

This competition will be run as a combined Swiss tournament, so Under 14 players may be paired against Under 16s. The leading points scorer will receive a £50 first prize. The leading Under 14 points scorer will receive £25. No player may receive 2 cash prizes. If players tie on the same number of points, cash prizes will be shared. The leading Richmond Junior Chess Club player will receive a trophy as 'RJCC Champion 2011' in addition to any cash prize won. A tie for this trophy will be broken by Sum of Progressive Scores and then by toss of coin if necessary.

### Under 12/10 Major

Trophy for LJCC Major qualifiers, plaques for Minor qualifiers.

### Under 8 Major

Trophy for LJCC qualifiers.

*Assistance will be given to players not familiar with using chess clocks in the above sections.*

### Under 11/9 Minor

Trophies for winners. Medals for scores of 5 out of 8 or more. Please note – winners do not qualify for LJCC finals.

**GRADING – results of the Under 16/14, Under 12/10 Major and Under 8 Major will be submitted to the English Chess Federation for grading.**

# About the LONDON JUNIOR CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS



The finals of the London Junior Chess Championships will be held at the University of Westminster, Northwick Park, Harrow. The Under 10 and Under 14 events are on 17th/18th December, The Under 8 event is on 29th/30th December and all the others are on 28th/29th/30th December.

Qualifying:- In the Under 8 section, a score of 4/6 or more on October 2nd will qualify you for the Finals of the London Junior Championships. In the Under 10 and Under 12 sections a score of 4½/6 will qualify you for the Major finals and a score of 3½/6 or 4/6 will qualify you for the Minor finals.
